



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY


Employees of Circle-C Energy Controls and contractors are responsible for the implementation of and compliance with this Policy.

In order to meet the above requirement, Circle-C Energy Controls will:

- Operate in line with AS/NZS ISO 14001 Environmental Management System;
- Comply with applicable environmental laws and regulations to prevent pollution and protect the earth's resources;
- Strive continuously to improve Circle-C Energy Controls' environmental performance by implementing environmental management procedures, regularly reviewing their effectiveness and rectifying deficiencies where necessary;
- Establish processes to review the environmental aspects and impacts of Circle-C Energy Controls' work activities prior to undertaking the work, and implement appropriate procedures to manage potential risks;
- Provide the support and resources necessary to ensure compliance with Circle-C Energy Controls and statutory requirements;
- Encourage process modifications that reduce pollution and waste;
- Implement and encourage internal recycling programs;
- Report and record environmental incidents and non-compliances, and initiate remedial actions to improve performance, rectify damages and prevent recurrences;
- Establish mechanisms for employees to report concerns about environmental issues and respond promptly to their concerns;
- Establish objectives and targets and monitor performance through the establishment of Key Performance Indicators; and
- Develop environmental awareness programs for employees and contractors and emphasise their obligations through education and training.
